Introduction

The 17th International Symposium on Nuclei in the Cosmos (NIC) will take place at the

Science Culture Center (SCC) of the Institute for Basic Science (IBS) and Daejeon Traffic

Culture Center in Daejeon (DTCC), Korea. NIC a major bi-annual conference in nuclear

astrophysics, covering nuclear physics, astrophysics, astronomy, cosmo-chemistry, and

Symposium schedule and format

NIC XVII will start on Sunday, Sep. 17, 2023 with a welcome reception. It will be followed by invited and contributed oral presentations from Sep. 18 to 22, 2023. During the symposium, poster sessions will also be held. NIC XVII will be in-person only.

Venue and access

The reception will be held at the Science Culture Center of IBS, and oral and poster presentations will take place at both the Science Culture Center and Daejeon Traffic Culture Center. Both buildings are adjacent to the IBS Headquarters, and are within walking distance. Daejeon is a metropolitan city with a population of about 1.4 million, located at ~150 km south of Seoul. Daejeon is known to be the Science City of Korea, home to many science, technology and research institutions and universities.

The registration fee will cover the symposium reception, coffee breaks, poster session snacks, excursion and banquet.
